CURRENT CASELOAD ALLOCATION PLAN

In accordance with Administrative Rule 1(E) of the Indiana Court Rules, the Owen Circuit Court hereby gives notice to the bar and the public that the Courts propose to Request For Approval To Revalidate Current Caseload Allocation Plan effective January 1, 2022. Said Request is pursuant to Administrative Rule 1(E) require Supreme Court approval and may not take effect until approved by the Supreme Court.

In accordance with Trial Rule 81(B), the time period for the bar and the public to comment shall begin June 1, 2021 and shall close on July 1, 2021. The proposed Request To Revalidate Current Caseload Allocation Plan will be adopted, modified or rejected before July 31, 2021 and the final version of the Request will be submitted to the Indiana Supreme Court for review and approval not later than August 1, 2021.
